On the back of a coffee stained placemat I had created a rough sketch of a document that would change the course of my life forever. It didn't happen overnight mind you, but it was the very first step of a journey that would take me to places I couldn't even imagine at the time.

That moment in time propelled me to master a process that has the power to change the lives of others and I've been able to do that, time and time again. I **need** to share this process with you.

This is a big, fat, glaring however!

All of these websites fail to do the three things that a website absolutely, positively must do. Those are the only three things that a website needs to do.

1. Automatically attract a steady stream of traffic from the World Wide Web.
2. Collect contact information along with permission to market to that person.

The Internet is so big and grows so fast I don’t think anybody, including Google, know for sure how websites there are online or how many new pages are added on a daily basis. But I was able to find these numbers . . .

One sources tells us that there are 634 million websites on the Internet.

There are 37 billion individual webpages on the Internet.

And it is estimated that well over 10,000 new websites are created daily.

It doesn't really matter whether or not those numbers are accurate, close to being accurate, or way off. What we know for sure is that there are tens of thousands of websites online, thousands of new ones being added daily and tens of thousands of new web pages being created daily.

Each and every one of those individual web pages has a job to do and quite frankly, they are not getting it done.
